Historic Courthouse  
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### Materials:Worsted weight yarn in 4 colors:

Main color (MC): color of choice for background  
(200 yds) Contrasting Color 1 (CC): White for body of goose – 35 yds  
Size 8 knitting needles  
CO 40 st MC  
R1-7: k  
R8: k4, p to last 4 st, k4  
R9: k  
R10: k4, p to last 4 st, k4  
Begin image  
R11: k8 MC, k20 CC, k12 MC  
R12: k4 MC, p7 MC, p22 CC, p3 MC, k4 MC  
R13: k6 MC, k24 CC, k10 MC  
R14: k4 MC, p5 MC, p26 CC, p1 MC, k4 MC  
R15: k4 MC, k28 CC, k8 MC  
R16: k4 MC, p2 MC, p30 CC, k4 MC  
R17: k4 MC, k31 CC, k5 MC  
R18: k4 MC, p1 MC, p31 CC, k4 MC

R41: k12 MC, k5 CC, k23 MC  
R42: k4 MC, p19 MC, p4 CC, p9 MC, k4 MC  
All MC:  
R43: k  
R44: k4, p to last 4 st, k4  
Repeat Rows 43 & 44 until scarf is about 40" long or about 6" shorter than desired length.  
End with an odd (R43) row, so that the next row will be an even row.  
Work rows 11-42 upside down (Rows 42-11) and the same time, work those rows back to reverse the image.  
Switch to all MC.  
Next row: k4, p to last 4 st, k4  
Next row: k  
Next row: k4, p to last 4 st, k4  
Next 7 rows: k  
BO and weave in ends.
